Caltrain will operate a regular [weekday schedule](#) for the Martin Luther King, Jr. holiday on Monday, January 15.

SamTrans will operate a regular, non-school day schedule for the holiday. Bus routes that primarily service local schools will not be operating that Monday.

The administrative offices of the San Mateo County Transit District, which manages SamTrans and Caltrain, will be closed for the holiday.

About Caltrain: Owned and operated by the Peninsula Corridor Joint Powers Board, Caltrain provides commuter rail service from San Francisco to San Jose, with limited commute service to Gilroy. Caltrain enjoyed five years of consecutive monthly ridership increases, surpassing more than 65,000 average weekday riders earlier this year. While the Joint Powers Board assumed operating responsibilities for the service in 1992, the railroad celebrated 150 years of continuous passenger service in 2014. Planning for the next 150 years of Peninsula rail service, Caltrain is on pace to electrify the system, reduce diesel emissions by 97 percent by 2040 and add more service to more stations.

The dream lives on this month as the Caltrain NorCalMLK [Celebration Train](#) makes its way up the Peninsula from San Jose to San Francisco on Monday, January 15.

The Celebration Train will provide free service for those who wish to attend the annual observance of the life and legacy of Dr. King in San Francisco hosted by the [Northern California Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Community Foundation \(NorCalMLK\)](#). There will be onboard activities and entertainment

for those in attendance during the trip, including a free giveaway for the children.

Attendees must register in advance to receive a free Celebration Train commemorative ticket. For ticket registration, click [HERE](#). Registration is open until 12 a.m. on January 14. This free train ride, which pays tribute to the 54-mile 1965 Selma to Montgomery March, is a great way to get to the MLK march and events in The City.

The train will depart from the San Jose Diridon Caltrain Station at 9:45 a.m. It will make stops in Palo Alto at 10:05 a.m. and San Mateo at 10:20 a.m. before arriving in San Francisco by 10:55 a.m. There is no special southbound service. However, Celebration Train tickets will be accepted on southbound trains departing San Francisco after 1 p.m. that day.
