Saturday, April 22, 7:30 pm, Daniel Castro Band
Daniel Castro is a highly accomplished dynamic blues guitarist who "leaves it all on the stage" at every show. Musical chemistry is obvious from the first note the band plays. With seasoned musicians, blistering solos, soulful singing, and tight arrangements, this trio brings the audience to its feet. You don't need advance tickets, just get them at the door between 7-7:30 pm. The dance floor will be open.

Cole Swings Cole—Long Live the Music re-creates the sound and style of the original Nat Cole Trio. George Cole, guitar and vocals; Sir Richard Nelson Hall, piano; and Carla Kaufman, bass, celebrate the chemistry ever so present in the musical interplay and countless hits of Nat Cole, Oscar Moore, and Wesley Price.

Saturday, May 6, 7:30 pm, Tango No. 9
Noche de Rhonda is an evening of romantic revelry with Catharine Clune, violin; Greg Stephens, trombone; and Joshua Raoul Brody, piano; and featuring dancer Mila Salazar and vocalist Zoltan DiBartolo. Come hear the nostalgia of tango from the early beat of milongo to the tango nueva. The dance floor will be open during some of the pieces when the professionals are not on the floor.

Saturday, May 13, 7:30 pm, Dan Bankhurst, virtuoso guitar, with special guest Jim Nichols
Influenced by blues, jazz, and finger-style guitar, Dan Bankhurst plays

Saturday, June 10, 7:30 pm, County Line Trio
County Line Trio pays A Salute to the Kingston Trio, the American folk/pop group that helped launch the folk revival of the late 1950s and 1960s. Playing such songs as "Tom Dooley" and "Charlie on the MTA," the trio delivers strong harmony, energy, and delightful fun in a trip down memory lane.

Saturday, June 17, 7:30 pm, Adam Rafferty, virtuoso guitar
Adam's funky finger-style guitar playing is popular the world over. Just this spring he has performed in Germany, Austria, and the Czech Republic before coming to California. Adam's second passion is teaching. He has several instructional DVDS, and has amassed more than 10 million YouTube views.

Saturday, June 24, 7:30 pm, SF Panhandlers, steel drum band
This nationally acclaimed group, led by Jim Muzenrider and featuring longtime Santana vocalist Tony Lindsay, has an extensive repertoire of socas, calypsos, and beguines. They've performed for the World Series at AT&T Park and are a mainstay at other big Bay Area events, such as the San Francisco AIDS Walk.
