

Friends,

TRT just released the results of a public opinion survey we commissioned to assess attitudes about water supply and conservation, the environment and development. You can review the report at <https://www.tuolumne.org/survey/>

As we had expected, the results were clear that the SFPUC's position on the Bay Delta Water Quality Control Plan is at odds with the values of its constituents. The survey demonstrated extremely strong support for protection and restoration of San Francisco Bay and the Tuolumne River. It also showed much stronger support for the creation of housing than office space — which 60% of respondents did not support. A vast majority felt Plan Bay Area would worsen their quality of life, and respondents supported making the SFPUC commissioners elected positions by a 2-1 margin.

2) If the final environmental document is released on Friday, we will encourage people to attend and speak in support of the Bay Delta Plan at the SFPUC meeting on Tuesday, July 10 at 1:30pm at SF City Hall, Room 400. Please let me know if you might be available to attend, and I'll be sure to keep you in the loop.

3) Attend and speak at the Bay Area Water Supply and Conservation Agency (BAWSCA) board meeting on Thursday, July 19 at 6:30pm at the San Mateo Library. BAWSCA represents the SFPUC's wholesale customers in San Mateo, Santa Clara and Alameda Counties. Again, please let me know if you might be able to attend, and I'll keep you posted.
