

Get the Facts on Measure C

In this time, when top politicians in our country believe that they can simply make up information and spread it, with no regard for the truth, it is disheartening to see that same thing happening in our little town. The No on C campaign has taken out two full-page ads in the Tribune. The most recent one has five statements in it which are simply not true: 1. Measure C does not have any impact on how many people can live in an apartment. The Rental agreement or lease controls that.

2. The rule being proposed under Measure C only applies to apartments built before 1995, it does not apply to single family homes.

3. The agency that will oversee the rules put into place by Measure C will be a city agency, and will be accountable to the city.

4. It is not a tax. It is a fee levied on apartments. Taxes require a 2/3 majority to win in California. Measure C went onto the ballot with a requirement for a majority vote.

5. It was well thought out and well written, by the City attorney, with input from many stakeholders.
