

Highway 1 between the Tom Lantos Tunnels at Devil's Slide and Linda Mar badly needs cleanup. Both shoulders are littered with trash, debris, weeds, and fallen tree limbs that only look terrible as you enter and leave Pacifica but also create a traffic hazard for vehicles and bicycles.

We submitted a maintenance request/complaint back on June 29 on the Caltrans District 4 [ONLINE FORM](#). Caltrans replied July 14 that it had "committed" to cleaning up this disgraceful stretch of highway between Linda Mar and the tunnels, but still NO ACTION.

**Please ask Caltrans to do its job: Call Jim Kennard at 510-286-4421 and Jose Montoya at 510-286-6227. Also, go online or the phone and contact Governor Brown, State Senator Jerry Hill, Pacifica City Council, and the San Mateo County Transportation Authority. There is no excuse for this delay!**

Removing trash, debris, weeds, and fallen tree limbs would help improve visibility on this dangerous "S" curve, where vulnerable bicyclists wobble up and down the narrow-to-nonexistent shoulders, taking their lives in their hands, while nervous motorists swerve to avoid them. It is one big traffic accident just waiting to happen, and when it does, it will be on Caltrans for failing to make this roadway safe and driveable. (Note: The crumpled, falling-down road sign finally was removed **at our request** September 29. Thank you, Caltrans, now please clean up the doggone highway!)
