

I received a fake email supposedly from Wells Fargo saying there was suspicious activity on my account (they didn't say which one), that they had suspended my account, and a link to click. It had a bogus feel to it so I logged onto my account and there were no messages. It was obviously not suspended. I called Wells Fargo and they agreed that this was a phishing email to get account information. They had me forward it to the following email address: [reportphish@wellsfargo.com](mailto:reportphish@wellsfargo.com). Over the years I have had several actual fraud notifications from Wells Fargo, and it is usually by phone and they just say contact us, with no links or phone numbers.
