

Officials have issued mandatory evacuation orders for Twin Sisters Road and Joyce Lane in Solano County, California, due to the Atlas Fire. These are the first mandatory evacuation orders for Solano County.

Fire station 5 in Santa Rosa, California, at 2201 Newgate Court, was among the hundreds of structures that burned Monday.

In addition to the 10 deaths reported by CalFire, Sonoma County has received up to 50 missing-persons reports.

Santa Rosa officials instated a mandatory curfew from 6:45 p.m. Monday until sunrise for the area of the city that was under evacuation orders. Anyone out in public overnight in the evacuated swaths of the city would be subject to arrest, Santa Rosa police warned.

After some looting was reported in Sonoma County by Sheriff Rob Giordano, Santa Rosa officials imposed a mandatory curfew from 6:45 p.m. daily until sunrise in the areas under evacuation. Anyone out in public overnight will be subject to arrest
