### **Watch for Your Sample Ballot & Official Voter Information Pamphlet for the November 3, 2020 Presidential General Election**

**(Redwood City, CA)** On September 24, the San Mateo County Registration & Elections Division will begin mailing the Sample Ballot & Voter Information Pamphlet for the November 3, 2020 Presidential General Election to registered voters.

“The Sample Ballot & Official Voter Information Pamphlet provides a wealth of information to voters on candidates, measures, and voter services for the upcoming general election,” said Mark Church, Chief Elections Officer and Assessor-County Clerk-Recorder. “The voter pamphlet will be provided to all eligible voters in the language indicated in their voter registration,” added Church.

they will no longer be mailed a paper copy of the pamphlet and will be notified by email when their pamphlet is available.
