Prowlers in Westview Neighborhood

Pacifica, CA – On August 22, 2022 at approximately 7:40 PM, officers responded to a residence on the 700 block of Lockhaven Drive for a report of a rear sliding glass door being smashed. The resident was home at the time, and the suspects responsible fled. During this investigation, it was determined other nearby residents had observed two male subjects going through backyards in the neighborhood. The subjects were last seen walking southbound through the brush into the nearby canyon. Witnesses were unable to provide a detailed description due to the heavy fog at the time, but said the subjects were both wearing dark hooded sweatshirts, and one was possibly wearing a dark colored flannel.

Less than one hour later, another resident in the 700 block of Claridge Drive reported they had also observed subjects in their backyard via security footage captured at 7:45 PM that same day. The subjects in the video appeared to be three Hispanic males and were heard speaking Spanish in the footage. All subjects were wearing face coverings. One was wearing a grey hooded sweatshirt, a black beanie, dark pants and white shoes. The second subject was wearing a black beanie, blue jacket or sweatshirt, dark pants. The third subject was wearing a green Oakland A's baseball hat with a yellow bill, a black jacket or sweatshirt and dark colored pants. Officers believe these subjects gained access to the backyard by climbing the fence along Skyline Boulevard (State Route 35).

Due to the timeframe, location, and clothing description, officers believe these same subjects were involved in these incidents. Residents in this Westview neighborhood are encouraged to check their security cameras for footage of these subjects, and to be on the lookout for suspicious activity. If you see something, say something. Please call 9-1-1 to report a crime in progress.
