Report of a Disturbance Results in Gun and Drug Arrest

Pacifica, Ca- On October 1, 2023 at approximately 11:04 PM, personnel from the Pacifica Police Department responded to the area of Paloma Avenue and Palmetto Avenue on the report of a possible domestic disturbance. The caller reported seeing a male subject, 31-year-old Jacob Mooney of Pacifica, involved in a disturbance with a female subject. Upon arrival officers located Mooney seated in his vehicle on Paloma Avenue. While speaking with Mooney officers observed a firearm and loaded magazine in the passenger area inside the vehicle. Mooney was detained without incident.

During the course of the investigation it was determined that Mooney had been involved in a physical domestic disturbance, causing injury. Mooney was also found in possession of a second firearm, controlled substances, and was determined to be under the influence of controlled substances.

Mooney was arrested and booked into San Mateo County Jail for the following violations:

- 273.5(A) PC- Inflict Corporal Injury on Spouse/Cohabitant etc. (Felony)
- 25400(A)(1) PC- Possession of a concealed firearm in a vehicle (Felony)
- 26350(A)(2)(A) PC- Carry unloaded firearm in public (Misdemeanor)
- 11377(A) HS- Possession of controlled substance (Misdemeanor)
- 11550(A) HS- Under the influence of a controlled substance (Misdemeanor)
