San Carlos Mayor Laura Parmer-Lohan Announces Run for San Mateo County Supervisor

San Carlos, CA –Local Mayor Laura Parmer-Lohan formally announced her candidacy for County Supervisor representing District 3, an open seat in 2022.

“I am thrilled at the overwhelming response I have received since deciding to enter this race over the holidays,” said Mayor Parmer-Lohan. “These challenging times demand leaders who will champion a vision of safe, vibrant and diverse neighborhoods that our children and workforce can afford to live in.”

County Supervisorial District 3, currently represented by Supervisor Don Horsley is a sprawling district that includes communities along the Coastside and suburban Peninsula cities. Horsley is serving his final term due to County term limits.

Continued Mayor Parmer-Lohan, “The unique and diverse character of this district means we must be prepared to ensure every community receives its fair share of resources for fire safety programs, workforce housing, and a healthy transit system to reduce traffic and increase air quality.”

“As County Supervisor, I’ll lead efforts to effectively address the wide-ranging health and fiscal impacts of COVID, which has disproportionately affected our seniors, communities of color, working moms, and the small businesses who give our communities vibrancy.”

Despite entering the race just recently in mid-December, Parmer-Lohan has already raised a war chest of \$50,000 and secured a broad coalition of endorsers who include former Assembly member and County Supervisor Rich Gordon; Dr. Aaron Nayfack, Sequoia Healthcare District Trustee; Shelly Masur, former Vice Mayor of Redwood City; and educational leaders and residents throughout the District.
