

PHS screens "In the Land of My Ancestors" on Friday, February 15 at 6:30 p.m. at the Museum.

Added to our opening of "The First Coastsiders" history exhibit (5 to 7 p.m.) is the local screening of a nine-minute documentary "In the Land Of My Ancestors" by filmmaker Rucha Chitnis. The film will be shown at 6:30 p.m. with a discussion to follow. This film features the incredible Ann Marie Sayers, Mutsun Ohlone, who continues to live in her ancestral homelands in Indian Canyon. She used the Indian Allotment Act of 1887 to reclaim her ancestral land in Hollister, California, and offered it to all indigenous peoples who needed a place for their religious ceremonies. Admission to the exhibit and screening is free; a donation to the continuing educational pursuits of the Pacifica Historical Society is appreciated.
