Three Arrested for Attempted Residential Burglary

Pacifica, CA- At approximately 2:00 pm on August 30, 2017 a suspicious subject was reportedly looking into a residence on the 600 block of Brighton Road. An alert neighbor saw this subject knock at the front door of this residence, and when there was no response, then enter the backyard. When confronted, this subject left and entered an awaiting white sedan being driven by another subject. The white sedan drove off eastbound on Brighton Road.

The alert neighbor immediately reported what had been seen to the Pacifica Police Department. Officers located the white sedan travelling southbound on State Route 1 near Westport Drive, not far from the involved residence. Officers stopped the vehicle and contacted three occupants. Through their investigation, it was determined the three had conspired to commit residential burglary and they were arrested. These subjects are identified as

Jose Omar Banos-Gomes, a 20 year old male resident of San Francisco,
Kevin Lamont Hunter, a 28 year old male resident of Los Angeles, and
Angela Xiomara Uribe-Martinez, a 20 year old female resident of San Francisco

These three subjects were booked at the San Mateo County Main Jail in Redwood City on charges of 664/460(a) of the Penal Code (Attempted Burglary of a Residence), and 182 of the Penal Code (Conspiring to Commit a Crime).

Evidence revealed during this investigation caused detectives to suspect these subjects had been involved in other burglaries and thefts. Anyone with information is encouraged to contact detectives at the Pacifica Police Department at 650-738-7314.

This is yet another positive example of Pacificans working in collaboration with their Police Department to help keep our community safe. Through the alert observations and actions of this community member, a home burglary was thwarted.
