Domestic Violence Suspect Apprehended

Pacifica, CA – On October 30, 2022 at approximately 7:30 AM, officers responded to the 500 block of Inverness Drive on the report of a domestic disturbance inside a parked vehicle. Officers arrived and attempted to contact the male subject involved, but he fled the scene on foot eluding pursuing officers. During the course of the investigation the male subject was identified as DARIEN DIAZ a 29-year-old resident of San Francisco, California. Officers also determined that he had been involved in a physical domestic dispute resulting in injuries to the other party.

As the investigation was continuing Dispatch received a report from a concerned community member regarding a suspicious subject matching DIAZ's description in the 500 block of Manor Drive. Officers from Pacifica PD responded to the area and located DIAZ, but he once again fled on foot and avoided pursuing officers by running through numerous backyards of residences located along the 500 block of Fremont Avenue, Del Mar Avenue, Johnson Avenue and Edgemar Avenue. Ultimately a perimeter was coordinated with the assistance of officers from the Daly City Police Department and the San Bruno Police Department, which included an officer with his K9 partner and an unmanned aerial vehicle, often referred to as a drone.

While on the perimeter, officers were alerted that DIAZ appeared to have entered a closed business on Oceana Boulevard. The San Bruno Police Department K-9 unit responded to the business. DIAZ eventually surrendered to officers and the K-9 unit around 9:00 AM. DIAZ was taken into custody without further incident and subsequently booked into San Mateo County Jail for an outstanding warrant for previous domestic violence charges and violation of the following Penal Code sections:

- 273.5(A) PC- Domestic Violence w/Injury
- 245(A)(1) PC- Assault w/Deadly Weapon
- 422(A) PC- Criminal Threats
- 236 PC- False Imprisonment
- 273.6(A) PC- Violation of Domestic Violence Court Order
- 148(A)(1) PC- Resist/Obstruct/Delay Officer(s)
