Several Parked Vehicles Targeted by Auto Burglary Crew

Pacifica, Ca- On August 21, 2024, at approximately 1:20 am Pacifica Police Officers responded to several reported vehicle burglaries on the 400 block of Heathcliff Drive and 500 block of Monterey Road. Officers arrived on scene and located several parked vehicles that were broken into during the early morning hours. As of this press release, approximately 20 victims have been identified.

Officers obtained some surveillance footage of the thefts from residents in the area. The suspects appeared to be associated with dark-colored sports utility vehicle (SUV), possibly a Dodge Durango. Three suspects were observed walking down the street, breaking into parked vehicles, while the dark color SUV followed close behind. The suspects were slender in build, wearing dark clothing, and appeared to be 18-25 years old. The thefts occurred in a matter of minutes, and the suspects quickly fled the area in the vehicle.

Pacifica Police Department would like to remind community members not to leave anything of value inside their parked vehicles and to always lock their vehicles. Community members are also encouraged to contact the Police Department if they witness any suspicious activity in their neighborhoods. *If you see something, say something.*
