## PRESS RELEASE

### December 15, 2022

#### Attempted Commercial Burglary Investigation

Pacifica, Ca- On December 14, 2022 at approximately 1:00 a.m. an officer on patrol noticed a suspicious subject near the corner of Manor Drive and Oceana Boulevard. The subject got into a white 2006 Dodge Ram pick up and left the area. The officer's suspicions were raised given the time of day, extreme cold weather at the time (estimated to be 38 degrees), and the fact there were no open businesses in this area. This officer coordinated with another officer to check nearby businesses for signs of criminal activity or burglary. The second officer located a shattered glass front door at a business on the 400 block of Oceana Boulevard. A traffic stop was initiated on the Dodge pick up and the subject was detained without incident for further investigation.

This subject was identified as John Bradford Boston, 53 years of age out of Atwater, California. During the course of this investigation officers located controlled substances, and Mr. Boston was arrested for 11377(a) HS, Possession of a controlled substance. The investigation into the attempted burglary of the closed business is ongoing.
