

San Mateo County authorities said they were investigating the death of a man and a woman found in a pond on a farm.

San Mateo County authorities on Thursday said they were investigating the deaths of a man and a woman found in a pond on a farm last week.

Officials from the San Mateo County Sheriff's Office were called to 4525 Cloverdale Road on Friday morning, after receiving a call about two individuals who were found dead in a pond on the property, said Lt. Eamonn Allen with the Sheriff's Office.

The property is located in the coastal town of Pescadero, south of Half Moon Bay.

The identities of the two individuals were not immediately released. The San Mateo County Coroner's Office declined to provide a cause of death on Thursday, saying the incident was still under investigation.

"We're waiting for the coroner's report to come back, but from all accounts it seems like it was an accidental drowning," said Allen.

Allen said officials believe the two individuals were employees at the farm located on Cloverdale Road. They apparently didn't show up for work Friday morning and were found dead in a pond, he said.
