U. S. Dept. of the Interior decision on Park Service plan to kill Tule Elk due Monday, September 13

Alexis Madrigal interviews Will Houston of Marin Independent Journal and others on KQED radio

The original plan in 1962 was for ranches to stay a limited period of time after selling the land to create Point Reyes National Seashore, after which they would vacate.

Today ranchers want 20 more years and other concessions to run their private business on public lands.

The vast majority of public comment was against the Park Service proposal to kill a number of Tule Elk. Private businesses and politicians support letting dairy ranches expand, and killing the elk.
