

The San Mateo County Board of Supervisors passed a new ordinance last week prohibiting “loud or unruly” gatherings where alcohol, cannabis and controlled substances are served to minors.

The ruling also says that it is the duty of any “responsible person” who knowingly hosts or allows a party to prevent the possession or consumption of any controlled substances by minors.

The ordinance goes into effect 30 days after the board formally adopts it.
